JCI Hong Kong officially kicked-off Ten Outstanding Young Persons Selection 2023

Ko Wing-man: HK youth shining on the international stage during the pandemic Grasp the new normal post-pandemic and Unleash youth creativity



[22 May 2023. Immediate release] Organised by Junior Chamber International Hong Kong (JCI Hong Kong), the "Ten Outstanding Young Persons Selection 2023" Kick-off Ceremony was held today. The committee announced that the nomination period for this year's Selection has officially begun and will run until 10th of July. Hong Kong people are encouraged to actively discover remarkable young individuals aged between 21 and 40 in their communities to participate in this year's awards.

Theme: Empowering Youth for a Brighter Future

The theme of this year is "Lead To Future", which refers to taking actions and making choices in the present moment to create a brighter future. The theme encourages Hong Kong youth to adopt a proactive attitude, promote the effective utilisation of time and resources in the present, and lay a solid foundation for a better future. The pursuit of a better society can begin now, paving the way for a brighter path in the future.

Several officiating guests attended today's Kick-off Ceremony, including Dr Ko Wing-man, GBS, JP, Chief Judge of Judging Panel; Mr Edward Au, Deloitte China Southern Region Managing Partner; Dr Leung Tung Yeung (2002 Awardee), President of the Outstanding Young Persons' Association, etc.

Mr Kenneth Yu, National President of JCI Hong Kong, expressed that the Ten Outstanding Young Persons (TOYP) Selection has a long history and is well-known by the society. It has been held for 51 years since 1970, selecting a total of 397 outstanding young individuals. He sincerely appreciates these awardees for continuing to contribute to Hong Kong and the world after being awarded. This year's theme emphasises the present, urging everyone to take immediate action and encourage our young people to participate and create a better future through the selection process. He said, "We must live in the present, participate in the present, and create the future. I hope all young people and future leaders will join the youth world of the present and work together to create a better dream."

Mr Edward Au, Deloitte China Southern Region Managing Partner, stated that the TOYP Selection reflects society's support for young people, encouraging them to achieve more in their respective fields. Since 1970, the event has become one of the most influential and credible youth selection activities in Hong Kong. Through a rigorous selection process, it identifies representative and influential young individuals from a pool of outstanding candidates. It is believed that their stories will inspire other young people in Hong Kong to progress and contribute more actively to society.

Ko: Grasp the New Normal Post-Pandemic and Unleash Youth Creativity

The judging panel for this year's awards consists of representatives from various sectors of society. The Chief Judge is Dr. Ko Wing-man, GBS, JP, a member of the Executive Council of HKSAR.

Dr Ko Wing-man, in his speech at the Kick-off Ceremony, expressed that this year marks a new chapter for Hong Kong and the TOYP Selection. "After three years of the pandemic, in addition to the 'new normal' coexisting with the virus, both technology and the international situation are in their respective new normals. In this new normal, it is crucial for Hong Kong's future development to quickly emerge from the shadow of the pandemic and find its position in the new normal."

He continued, JCI Hong Kong has chosen "Future" as the theme for the TOYP Selection for two consecutive years, demonstrating the hopes of young entrepreneurs for Hong Kong's new chapter and the proactive attitude of young people in creating new opportunities. "Last year, our focus on the future was on 'observing' and 'building,' encouraging young people to observe the real needs of society and construct comprehensive ideas. This year's focus is on the 'present,' seizing existing resources and advantages, taking immediate action, and promoting Hong Kong towards a brighter future."

Dr Ko Wing-man pointed out that the power of youth is an important indicator of social development. Hong Kong's young people have achieved outstanding accomplishments on the international stage over the past three years, including the recognition of Dr Ricky

Chiu, TOYP Selection 2021 awardee, as a Ten Outstanding Young Persons of the World. This demonstrates that the brilliance of Hong Kong's young people cannot be concealed by the pandemic. "I look forward to seeing not only increasing consumption and outbound tourism from Hong Kong residents after the lifting of pandemic restrictions but also the creativity of Hong Kong's youth!"

Sharing the Experience from 2022 TOYP Awardees

Mr Steven Pun, TOYP awardee last year, shared that he started his own business and ventured into the field of innovative technology. He mentioned that in the initial stages, he might have to invest a lot of time and money without necessarily receiving immediate returns. However, as the company grows, it not only benefits his own company but also creates benefits for suppliers, customers, and society as a whole. He advised young people who aspire to become outstanding youths to be role models and exert influence within their respective fields. He emphasised that the most important aspect of entrepreneurship is understanding how to manage one's time effectively.

Another awardee from last year, Mr Calvin Tse, shared that besides creating wealth through his business, he also hopes to gain more social resources and networks to help more young people in society. He drew inspiration from past challenges, such as the SARS and COVID-19 epidemics, to encourage young people, stating that difficult situations often pass with time. He also shared an encounter where young people asked him about the best time to start a business, to which he responded that there is no perfect time but rather a suitable mindset. He emphasised that taking the first step is crucial, and with a positive mindset, success is possible in any endeavour.

The result and information of awardees will not be released by the Organizer to the public and media until the official announcement at the Press Conference to be held on 8 October 2023.

The program aims to give formal recognition to those young people who excel themselves in their professional endeavour and commitments to the community; to promote prominent roles played by aspiring young people in shaping a better future for society; and to provide an incentive to all promising young people who seek further advancement in personal achievements as well as public services.
